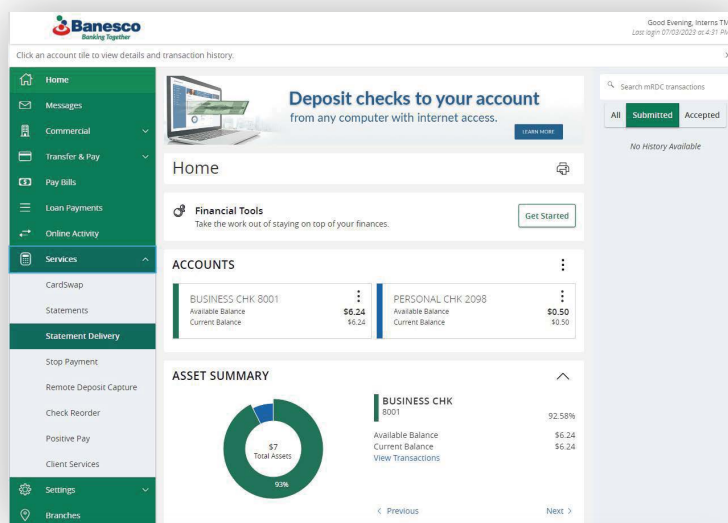
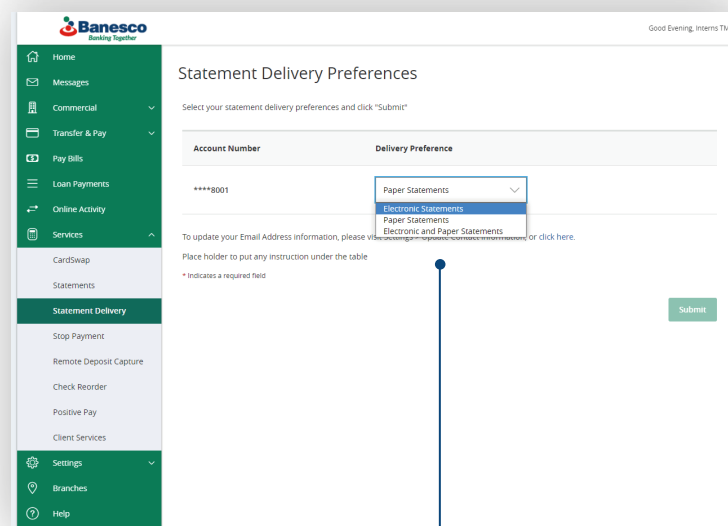


Statements Delivery

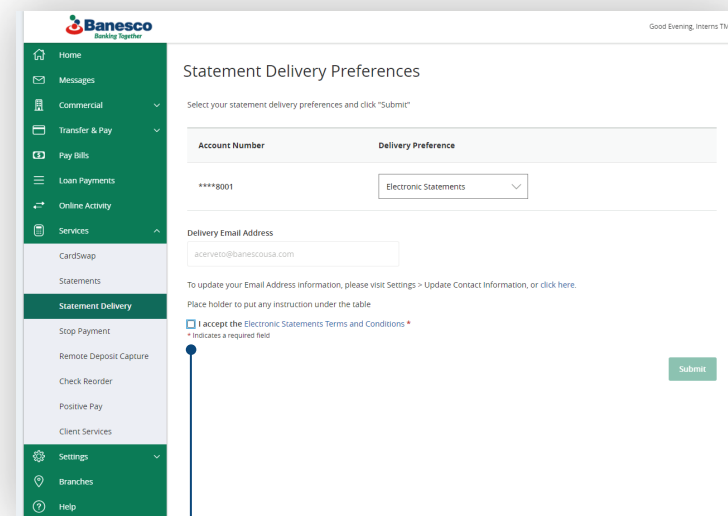
1. From the menu, click “Services”, and then click “Statements Delivery.”
